Confidentiality of the Association's Officers and Employees

March 24, 1992 Resolution of the Board of Directors

The officers and employees of the Association and persons entrusted with the Association's operations (meaning members of the Association's committees, their subordinate organs, and advisory organs or the like to the Chairman; members of the Secretariat; and other staff members) may not divulge any secret that has come to their knowledge in the course of their duties. The same applies after they have left from their position.
